

Dedication Garden Tree Request

About this Request

Newbiggin by the Sea Town Council, in conjunction with Northumberland County Council, has established an area of open land opposite Memorial Park for the dedication of trees by residents or compatriots of Newbiggin by the Sea in memory of their deceased loved ones.

Trees will be planted twice a year during winter to maximise the likelihood of the trees' survival. Certain terms and conditions apply to any request; please carefully read them at the back of this leaflet.

The Process

1. Complete the **request form**, along with a cheque to cover total costs, and post it to:

Newbiggin by the Sea Town Council, Town Clerk, Town Council Offices, Community Arts Centre, Woodhorn Lane, Newbiggin by the Sea, Northumberland NE64 6PY.

- 2. The Town Clerk will acknowledge receipt of your request and inform you of the next planting and dedication service.
- 3. You will be invited to the dedication service where you will be able to plant your tree.



Terms and Conditions

- 1. All trees and artefacts remain the property of Newbiggin Town Council.
- 2. No human or animal remains may be buried in or around the area. Ashes may be scattered in or around the area. The area designated is not a burial or internment site
- 3. Trees and artefacts can only be included in the Dedication Garden with written permission of Newbiggin Town Council.
- 4. The cost of the trees, plaques, tree supports and maintenance must be paid in full and in advance of the trees being dedicated into the Garden. All money received through this scheme will be used to finance the purchase of trees, guards and maintenance works. Remaining money will be transferred to the Friends of the Dedication Garden for future investment in the area.
- 5. Trees can only be planted at specific times of year as directed by Newbiggin Town Council. This is to ensure that trees are planted in their dormant stage to provide the tree with the greatest chance of survival. Trees will be planted as part of a multi-faith dedication service arranged by the Newbiggin Town Council.
- 6. Only trees that are approved by Newbiggin Town Council may be planted in the Dedication Garden. This is to ensure that hardy trees that are suited to the environment and surroundings are planted and are likely to survive.
- 7. The Dedication Garden will be maintained jointly by the Friends of the Dedication Garden, Newbiggin Town Council and Northumberland County Council.
- 8. You will automatically become part of the Friends of the Dedication Garden, but can opt out of the group at any time. You are strongly encouraged to take an active role in the Friends group, to maintain and develop the Dedication Garden.
- 9. Terms and Conditions may be changed by Newbiggin Town Council at any time and without any prior notice.

Friends of the Dedication Garden

The Friends of the Dedication Garden is a group of individuals involved in maintaining and improving the Dedication Garden. The Friends group aims to:

- Work with Newbiggin Town Council and Northumberland County Council as partners to develop and maintain the Dedication Garden.
- Represent the wishes of the relatives and friends of those dedicated in the Garden.
- Access funding and voluntary sector support services to further their aims.

The Friends is a constituted membership organisation that anyone can join, and to which those making a request for a memorial tree are automatically joined. Membership is free, but a donation of £2 is suggested from those who have not planted a tree or who did so more than three years ago. Monies raised will be used by the Friends to further enhance the Garden.

Swedish Whitebeam (Sorbus intermedia) Deciduous, grey bark, dome shaped crown, stout horizontal branches, green upper leaves with white hairs underneath.	£100		
Rowan (Sorbus aucuparia) Deciduous, smooth silvery grey bark turning scaly grey-brown, hairy leaves with white flowers and red berries.	£100		
Silver birch (Betula pendula) Deciduous, slender trunk, arched branches, white bark, catkins producing winged seeds.	£100		
Holly (Ilex aquifolium) Evergreen, smooth grey bark, sharp spines on leaves, white flowers producing bright red berries in winter.	£100		
Sycamore Maple (Acer pseudoplatanus) Deciduous, dark green leaves with red stalks.	£100		
Wild Cherry (Prunus avium) Deciduous, smooth purplish-brown bark, red or orange leaves in autumn, dark purple/red cherries.	£100		



Small-leaved Lime (<i>Tilia cordata</i>) Deciduous, heart-shaped leaves, rich heavy scent attractive to bees.	£100
