### GC09/13 APPLICATIONS FOR GRANT

The Town Clerk reported on the receipt of several further applications for grant assistance and circulated the details of the applications which each demonstrated degrees of community benefit for local organizations.

Members were keen to see the training initiatives develop that were proposed by Blyth Resource and Initiative Centre at East Lea and to be available to as many people as possible and throughout the wider town if possible. They were encouraged by the desire to strengthen the new community group Newbigginers at East Lea and intended activities.

It was noted that the Northumberland County Blind Association had over 140 members and service users in the town with nearly half receiving recent rehabilitation. They were keen to highlight accessibility in the town at an event to be held on 8 September.

A new ladies football club would provide an opportunity for a percentage of girls from the town to play on Sunday afternoons.
