**GC13/17 APPLICATIONS FOR GRANT**

Copies of seven new applications for grant were considered by the Committee. Support was sought from a range of local organizations for projects providing activities in the community and local competitors attending national championships.

**RESOLVED that:**

- (i) A grant of £283.51 be awarded to the Little Gem Arts & Crafts Gallery to provide a sign to advertise the new premises as outlined in application No 17/05;
- (ii) A grant contribution of £122.27 be awarded for application No 17/06 for Newbiggin RNLI Lifeboat Station information web site;
- (iii) A grant of £300 was agreed towards the cost of providing materials for children's arts activities for application No 17/07 at Newbiggin Youth Art Club;
- (iv) Grants of £300 be awarded for applications No 17/08 & 09 to M Common and A Douglass towards competition expenses in the British Judo Championships;
- (v) Subject to confirmation that access to the exhibition and children's workshops would be free of charge a grant contribution of £300 be awarded to Newbiggin Heritage Partnership application No 17/10 towards the Touring Craft Exhibition Workshops;
- (vi) A grant contribution of £300 was agreed towards the cost of upgrading the ceilings in the ladies toilets and office for Newbiggin Bowling Club application No 17/11.
