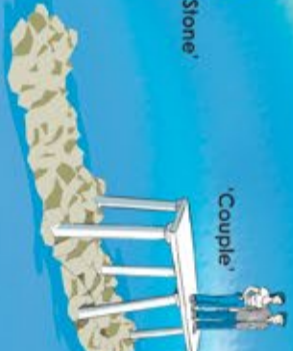
The Little Gem Art and Crafts Gallery is open every Saturday 10am to 4pm and Sunday 12noon to 4pm.

 In the bay, stands Couple (alternatively called Ebu and Fo) by the beach. The UK's first permanent offshore network. A miniature version of Couple can also be viewed on the promenade near to the Lifeboat Station.
